We will be sad to see William leaving us in the near future when his baby sister arrives.


Taylor will be leaving us at the end of the summer term when his mum finishes her college course.

Childcare vouchers can save many parents with kids aged up to 15 over £1,000 a year on childcare. Frustratingly, it's only available via employers, but many large and small companies take part.

The key is they enable you to pay for childcare out of your PRE-TAX and National Insurance income. While this doesn't sound much, the benefit is huge.

I am already registered with Busy Bees, Computershare and Co-op for their vouchers but will happily register with any other agency that your employer uses.

If you do hear of anyone having a clear out of any toys or play equipment please let me know as I am always interested in expanding my range of equipment.




## REMINDER:
